Through our third party certification with the U.S. Department of Veteran’s Administration and our Certificate of Authority as an engineering company with the State of New York, POZ-PC was granted similar status with the newly formed NY OGS Veteran’s program. We are excited with the new market and the opportunities it presents to POZ. As engineers we want to improve the way we live and maintain our environmental quality.

POZ has been in business since 2005 establishing markets in the Federal and State sectors as engineers. Our projects consisted of multi-disciplinary engineering practices ranging in cost from \$1K to \$550K in

POZ Captures Multiple Work Orders

POZ was recently awarded four design work orders from the PA DGS under their A&E small business contract. These work orders consisted of: two generator projects (2-130KW and a 200KW with ATSS and concrete pads), a water

loop (8-inch pipe to replace water supply line to boiler plants at a State facility that failed to meet the desired pressure), and turning target system (mechanical turning target systems). In three of these work orders POZ performed the survey

cost estimate.

We were awarded these projects from a short list with competition from other small firms. We continue to be successful in this market because we strive to satisfy the client’s needs.

In addition, he maintains a current database with NCEES for additional reciprocity. Emanuel has 30 years of experience with the federal government designing, managing, engineering, and estimating cost for over 200 projects with various types of design criteria (civil, environmental, geo-technical, and structural). He is also a military veteran serving a total of 24 years (2 years active duty Army, 15 years active Army Reserves, and 7 year active US Air Force Reserves). He served during Viet Nam, Desert Storm, and Enduring Freedom.

We have a multi-disciplinary engineering staff (electrical, mechanical, civil, environmental, and structural) for project design, management, and quality assurance. We also have environmental scientists, geologists, inspectors, and surveyors.

We are familiar with building and environmental codes such as NEC, IBC, NEPA, CERCLA, RCRA, etc. Our design documents are edited internally before submission to the customer, who are included in the process to keep communication between teams ongoing and to receive constructive feedback and satisfaction.

We are familiar with and composed a library of standardized specification formats such as those listed in Master Format and USACE, and can adapt to other formats as needed. We use AutoCAD Infrastructure Suite (latest version) to model our drawing design to follow BIM concepts for 3D viewing. Each element of the design is done by the prospective engineering discipline then edited by our principle reviewer for each project. POZ offers two levels of quality assurance and control with the final submission done by Emanuel. POZ has met timelines, regulatory goals, eliminated or minimized cost overrun, and provided QA for the success of each project.

We carry worker's compensation for PA and NY. We also have automobile, general, errors and omissions, and pollution liability insurances.
